## CUSTOMS AMENDMENT BILL.

AMENDMENT proposed by His Excellency the Governor-General:

Clause 13, subclause (1): To omit this subclause, and substitute the follow-

ing subclause:

(1) For the purposes of the Tariff the Minister may direct that sawn dressed timber or any class of such timber shall be measured as if the actual thickness thereof were increased by such amount as he may prescribe in that behalf. The maximum amount that may be so added in any case shall, as the Minister may determine, be either three-sixteenths of an inch, or twenty per centum of the actual thickness. Every direction under this section shall be given by notice published in the Gazette, and may at any time be in like manner revoked.
