CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DUTIES BILL.

Mr. T. Mackenzie, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Schedule B, Class VII., page 10: To strike out after word "ironmongery" "except," and to add after "legging buckles" "trace and plough chains or metal articles required to repair or complete riding or driving harness or saddlery to be repaired or made in the colony."

Schedule B, Class XII., page 11, top line: To strike out "or chains made

up with attachments."

Mr. Massey, in Committee, to move the following:—

Schedule A, Class VII.: That the duty on boots, shoes, and slippers be reduced from the several rates set forth in the Schedule to 20 per cent. all round.

Mr. Button, in Committee, to move—

Schedule A, Class VII.: That the proposed duty on leather be amended as follows, viz.:—

Waxed calf, 1d. per pound.
Sole leather, 1d. per pound.
E.I. kip, 1d. per pound.
Buff or satin hide and split, 2d. per pound.

Mr. Buick, in Committee, to move—

That sheep-shears be added to Schedule B.
