NOTICES RELATING TO ORDERS OF THE DAY.

CEMETERIES BILL.

Mr. HUTCHISON, in Committee, to move the following:—

That in any case where persons have purchased and paid for burial sites in any cemetery which it is found necessary to close, and in which burial sites no interments have been made up to the time of closing the same, these persons shall be entitled, on production of satisfactory proof of their purchases, to a free grant of ground for burial sites in the new cemetery, equal in amount to that which they owned in the cemetery which has been closed.
