CONSTITUTION BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 3 Separate Bills

Right Hon. GEOFFREY PALMER, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 29 to 37 and the Third Schedule* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 29* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title and commencement:

An Act to amend the Acts Interpretation Act 1924

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Acts Interpretation Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Acts Interpretation Act 1924 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1987.

That *clauses 38 to 46* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 38* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title and commencement:

An Act to amend the Electoral Act 1956

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Electoral Amendment Act (No. 2) 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electoral Act 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1987.
