Proposed Amendments

Mr Bruce Barclay, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 4: To add the following subclauses:

(4) Nothing in section 17 or section 18 of the Reserves and Domains Act 1953 shall apply in respect of the Botanic Gardens and the International Gravity Base Tie Station, being the land described in the First Schedule to this Act.

(5) No part of the Botanic Gardens and the International Gravity Base Tie Station may be taken or set apart under the Public Works Act 1928 for a road, street, motorway, or bridge.

Clause 6: To omit subclauses (3) and (4) as inserted by the Lands and Agriculture Committee, and substitute the following subclauses:

(3) Nothing in section 17 or section 18 of the Reserves and Domains Act 1953 shall apply in respect of Cranmer Square, Latimer Square, Godley Statue Block, Victoria Square and land on the banks of the Avon River between Antigua Street and Barbadoes Street being the land described under items 1, 2, 3, 35, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 in the Third Schedule to this Act.

(4) No part of Cranmer Square, Latimer Square, Victoria Square and land on the banks of the Avon River between Antigua Street and Barbadoes Street as described under items 1, 2, 3, 35, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 in the Third Schedule to this Act may be taken or set apart under the Public Works Act 1928 for a road, street, motorway, or bridge.
