ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS SALE CONTROL ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. BUICK, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

25. If, at any period during which any premises are required under the provisions of this Act to be closed, any person is found on such premises, he shall, unless he satisfies the Court that he was an inmate, servant, or a lodger on such premises, or a *bonâ fide* traveller, or that otherwise his presence on such premises was not in contravention of the provisions of this Act with respect to the closing of licensed premises, be liable to a penalty not exceeding *forty shillings*.

CUSTOMS DUTIES BILL.

Mr. JOYCE, in Committee, to move:—

That all fabrics in the piece made of cotton of the value of sixpence or under per yard shall be admitted duty-free; but if such fabrics be made up into clothing or otherwise, then to bear a duty of twenty-five per centum.
