CINEMATOGRAPH FILMS AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr Higher, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 2: To omit subclause (2) on page 2.

To add to the definition of the term "film festival", in lines 39 to 41 on that page, the words ", and that is intended to be exhibited within a period not exceeding 4 weeks, with no one film in the programme being exhibited on more than 4 occasions".

Clause 18A: To omit all the words in lines 16 and 17 on page 14.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 2: The first amendment is consequential upon changes made by the Commerce and Energy Select Committee.

The second amendment changes the definition of the term "film festival", as inserted by that Committee. It limits the length of the festival to 4 weeks, and provides that no film may be shown more than 4 times in that period.

Clause 18A: The amendment is consequential upon the second amendment proposed in respect of clause 2.
