COMMERCE LAW REFORM BILL 1990

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 3 Bills

Hon. DAVID BUTCHER, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 2 to 43B* be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Commerce Act 1986

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Commerce Amendment Act 1990 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Commerce Act 1986 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1990.
- (3) Sections 3 (1), (3), (4), (5), and (6), 15A, 16, 22, 25A, 25B, (except subsection (1) (b)), 25c, 27, 28, 29, 29A, 29B, 41, 43, 43A, and 43B of this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1991.

That clauses 44, 44A, and 45 be a separate Bill and that for clause 44 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Fair Trading Act 1986

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Fair Trading Amendment Act 1990 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fair Trading Act 1986 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
 - (2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1990.

That *clauses 46 to 58* be a separate Bill and that for clause 46 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Amendment Act 1990 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1990.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper divides the Commerce Law Reform Bill 1990 into 3 separate Bills.
