CUSTOMS DUTIES BILL.

Mr. MASSEY, in Committee, to move,—

1. That patent medicines for horses, cattle, and sheep be admitted free of duty.
2. That fencing-wire be admitted free of duty.
3. That fittings for ploughs be admitted free of duty.
4. That canvas aprons and elevators for reapers and binders be admitted free of duty.
5. That bill-hooks be admitted free of duty.

ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS SALE CONTROL ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. CARNELL, in Committee, to move—

To strike out all the words after the word "order" in line 13, clause 34, and add the following: "he is liable to a penalty not exceeding *five* pounds, and any licensed person who permits any person against whom a prohibition order is in existence to be or to remain on his licensed premises shall be liable to a penalty of not less than *five* pounds and not exceeding *ten* pounds.

CORRUPT PRACTICES PREVENTION ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. SEDDON, in Committee, to move the following new sub-clauses to follow clause 11:—

- (1.) If such return is not duly transmitted within the time prescribed by this Act the defaulting candidate shall be liable to a penalty of *fifty* pounds for every day thereafter on which he sits or votes in the House of Representatives, until such return is transmitted.
- (2.) Every candidate who transmits a return which is false in any material point is guilty of a corrupt practice, unless he satisfies the Court that he had no intention to misstate or conceal the facts.

In clause 13, line 3, after the words "twelve months after," insert "it is" in lieu of "they are."

In the First Schedule, in third line of italics, after the words "person on his" insert the words "order or."
