Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Bill

Proposed amendments

Murray Smith, in committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 1

To omit the words “(Clean Slate)”, and substitute the word “(Concealment)”.

New clause 14B

To insert, after clause 14A (after line 2 on page 25), the following clause:

14B Offence to knowingly provide false information or advice concerning criminal record

- (1) A person commits an offence if the person has a criminal record which is not required to be concealed under the clean slate scheme and provides information or advice to any other person concerning the existence or nature of that criminal record knowing it to be false.
- (2) A person who commits an offence against **subsection (1)** is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.
