CONSOLIDATED STOCK ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Bell, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Notwithstanding anything contained in the third section of "The Consolidated Stock Act, 1891," it is hereby declared that loans raised under the provisions of "The Government Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1886," and the Acts amending the same, shall be deemed to have been and to be convertible into stock, but the provisions of "The Consolidated Stock, Act, 1884," relating to the creation of stock and the issue of debentures against the sinking funds of loans and the accretions thereof shall not henceforth apply or be deemed to apply to such loans.

ELECTORAL ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir R. Stout, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clauses:—

All co-operative labourers shall be entitled to such facilities as shall enable them to record their votes where they usually reside.

No persons shall be allowed to assemble in or near any polling-booth, or within fifty yards of such polling-booth, and any one offending against this provision shall be liable to a penalty of not more than *five* pounds.

Mr. Collins, in Committee, to move the following addition to clause 2:—

And provided further that the last-mentioned provision of this clause shall have no operation after the last day of December, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.
