CONSOLIDATED STOCK ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. MONTGOMERY, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Nothing in "The Consolidated Stock Act, 1884," or the amendments thereof, shall be deemed to authorise the issuing of debentures against the sinking fund of the Government Loans to Local Bodies.

EIGHT HOURS BILL.

Mr. MOORE, in Committee, to move the following proviso to clause 4:—

Provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent the workers in woollen-factories working forty-eight hours per week. The working-hours to be so arranged as to provide that on one day in each week five consecutive working-hours shall constitute a day's work.
