CONTRACEPTION, STERILISATION, AND ABORTION BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr GANDAR, in Committee to move the following amendments:

Clause 56: To add to subclause (1), after the proposed subsection (1E) (as set out in Supplementary Order Paper No. 47), the following proposed subsection:

“(1F) If any teacher states in writing to the Head Teacher of the school in which he is employed that he does not wish to teach courses or classes in human development and relationships, then nothing in this Act shall be construed as requiring him to do so.”

To add to subclause (2), after the proposed subsection (6) (as set out in Supplementary Order Paper No. 47), the following proposed subsection:

“(7) If any teacher states in writing to the Principal of the school in which he is employed that he does not wish to teach courses or classes in human development and relationships, then nothing in this Act shall be construed as requiring him to do so.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The amendments provide that teachers may decline to take courses and classes in human development and relationships.
