CHILD SUPPORT BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 3 Bills

Hon. WYATT CREECH, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 1 to 4, Parts I to XIV, Part XVII, and Part XVIII* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 1* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act—

- (a) To assess the minimum level of financial support payable by certain parents in respect of their children; and
- (b) To provide for the collection and payment of child support and spousal maintenance payments; and
- (c) To make transitional arrangements relating to maintenance liabilities under the Social Security Act 1964 and the Family Proceedings Act 1980

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Child Support Act **1991**.

(2) This Act is hereby declared to be one of the Inland Revenue Acts within the meaning of the Inland Revenue Department Act 1974, and the First Schedule to that Act is hereby accordingly amended by adding a reference to this Act.

(3) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section and section 299 of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

(4) Part XI and Part XVII of this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1992.

That *Part XV* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 244* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Social Security Act 1964

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Social Security Amendment Act (No. 5) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security Act 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1992.

That *Part XVI* be a separate Bill with the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Family Proceedings Act 1980

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Family Proceedings Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Family Proceedings Act 1980 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1992.
