CHATELS TRANSFER BILL.

Hon. Mr. PARR, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 57, subclause (8): To omit the word "passing" and substitute the word "commencement."

Clause 59: To omit the clause, and substitute the following new clause:—

Certain provisions of this Act to apply to mortgages, charges, and debentures granted or issued by companies.

59. Sections *twenty-nine, thirty, thirty-three, sections thirty-five to forty-one, sections forty-six to fifty-four, and section fifty-eight* hereof shall apply in all respects to mortgages, charges, and debentures granted or issued by any company and registered with the Registrar of Companies pursuant to the provisions of the Companies Act, 1908, in the same manner and to the same effect as if such mortgages, charges, or debentures were instruments by way of security.
