DEFENCE AMENDMENT BILL.

Right Hon. Sir J. G. WARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 7: Omit subclauses (1) and (2), and substitute the following:—

(1.) The Minister of Defence and the Minister of Education may at the request of the controlling authority take over the control of the Boy Scouts, or permit the formation of Boy Scout units in the Senior and Junior Cadets respectively.

(1A.) Such units may be designated Boy Scout Cadets, and wear the Scout uniform, but shall be subject to the provisions of the principal Act so far as they relate to Senior and Junior Cadets.

(2.) The training of the Boy Scout Cadets shall be as prescribed for Senior and Junior Cadets, and in addition they may practise the training set out in the Scout-training text-book.

Clause 8: Omit the word "exceed" in line 32, and substitute the words "be less than."

Clause 9: Omit paragraph (a).

To add the following new clause:-

Section 72 of principal Act extended.

10a. Section seventy-two of the principal Act shall extend and apply to members of the Defence Forces when attending any drill or exercise, and while going to or returning from any drill or exercise, and to officers of the Forces at all times.
