DIVORCE AND MATRIMONIAL CAUSES AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. McCallum, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

A. Section twenty-one of the principal Act is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraph to subsection one thereof:—

“(g.) On the ground that the respondent is a person of unsound mind and is unlikely to recover, and in the opinion of the Court has been continuously a person of unsound mind for a period of seven years immediately prior to the filing of the petition, and during the final three years of the said period of seven years has been confined as a person of unsound mind in a public institution in accordance with the provisions of the Mental Defectives Act, 1911.”
