DAIRY-PRODUCE EXPORT CONTROL AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. NASH, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 5, subclause (2): To strike out all words after the word "shall" in the fourth line, and insert the following words: "be entitled to vote in accordance with his supply of butterfat to such factory as follows: From one thousand pounds to two thousand nine hundred and ninety-nine pounds (both inclusive), one vote; from three thousand pounds to four thousand nine hundred and ninety-nine pounds (both inclusive), two votes; five thousand pounds and over, three votes."

Clause 5, subclause 4: To strike out all the words after the word "to" in the second line, and substitute the following: "vote as herein provided on his aggregate supply of butterfat to such factories."

Clause 5, subclause 5: At the end of the subclause to add the following words: "in accordance with the foregoing provisions."

Clause 6: To strike out subclauses (2) and (3).

Clauses 7 and 8: To delete the whole of both clauses.

Second Schedule: To delete the whole of this Schedule.

To add the following new clause:—

A. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the principal Act, no notice by the Board under section thirteen of the principal Act of its intention to assume absolute control shall take effect before the first day of September, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven.
