## DAIRY INDUSTRY AMENDMENT BILL

*Proposed Amendments*

Hon. Mr MACINTYRE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 4:* To omit the words “; and the Director-General may require details of one sort for a product if it is intended for export and details of another sort if it is not so intended”.

*Clause 5:* To omit lines 30 to 33 on page 2, and substitute the words:

“5. **Regulations**—Section 32 of the principal Act is hereby amended by”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

It now seems possible that the empowering of the Director-General to require dairy produce sold in New Zealand to be labelled with details of its nature and composition, or to prescribe standards of quality, purity, and composition in respect of such dairy produce, might interfere with existing powers of the Director-General of Health. These amendments have the effect of leaving matters in this field to the Director-General of Health.
