DECLARATORY JUDGMENTS BILL.

Hon. Mr. McNAB, in Committee, to move to add the following new clause:—

Costs.

13. The costs of any action, summons, or appeal under this Act shall be in the discretion of the Court, and the Court may in the exercise of that discretion order the whole or any part of those costs to be paid by any party, although successful in the action, summons, or appeal, and may in any case direct that costs awarded to any party shall be taxed either as between party and party or as between solicitor and party.
