DESIGNATION OF DISTRICTS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. McNAB, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Section 2. Strike out the words "Amendment Act," in second line thereof.

New clauses.

1A. The powers granted to the Governor in the fourth section of "The Designation of Districts Act, 1894," to require the local authority to submit a new name or names for places which bear a name so similar to another or others, with or without a prefix, as to lead to mistakes or confusion, shall be exercisable only with the consent of the local authority, or, if such consent cannot be obtained, only upon application to a Judge of the Supreme Court.

1B. Notice of such application shall be given by advertisement published in two successive issues of any newspaper circulating in the district within which is situated the place affected by the proposal contained in such application, and any person resident at or near such place may, at the hearing of such application, object to the proposed alteration.
