DEFINITION OF TIME BILL.

Mr. SIDNEY, in Committee, to move to omit clause 3, and substitute the following new clause therefor:—

Clock time in
winter and
summer months.

3. From the hour of two in the morning of the first Sunday in November, nineteen hundred and seventeen, until the hour of two in the morning of the first Sunday in March, nineteen hundred and eighteen, and from the hour of two in the morning of the first Sunday in October, nineteen hundred and eighteen, and in each year thereafter, until the hour of two in the morning of the first Sunday in March of the following year, New Zealand clock time shall be one hour in advance of New Zealand standard time, and from the hour of two in the morning of the first Sunday in March in each year until the hour of two in the morning of the first Sunday in October in that year New Zealand clock time shall be the same as New Zealand standard time.
