NAVAL AND MILITARY SETTLERS.

Mr. G. Hutchison to move, on the resumption of the Adjourned Debate on the Question, "That the Report of the Waste Lands Committee on Petitions of Naval and Military Settlers do lie on the Table, and that the Report and Petitions be referred to the Government," to add, by way of amendment, the following words:—

"And that the Government appoint a Commission to report to Parliament in next session upon such rejected claims as have been sent in in time, and those which are the subject of petitions presented this session, including as a class those rejected on the ground that the claimants had received grants of land for services prior to those in respect of which claims have been made."

LAND ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Rhodes, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Any selector under Part III. of the said Act or under the provisions of any former Act relating to the occupation of land under similar tenure may apply to the Board to have a reclassification made of the allotment in his occupation.

The Board may hear any such application, and may make inquiry into each case, and if they see fit may order a reclassification to be made of any allotment the subject of such inquiry, or may confirm the classification appealed against.

If the Board shall determine to reclassify any allotment then the requirements as to improvements shall be those attaching to the class to which the allotment has been reduced.

EDUCATION ACT AMENDMENT BILL (No. 2.)

Mr. Meredith, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 5, line 22: That the words "Education Board" be struck out with the view of inserting the words "School Committee."

Clause 5: New subsection:

With respect to any public school used in connection with a Normal school, this section shall be used and shall take effect as if the words "Education Board" had been inserted therein instead of the words "School Committee."

CRIMINAL CODE AMENDMENT BILL.

Clause 192, subsection of section 2, in line 16: To strike out "fourteen" and insert "sixteen."
