ELECTORAL ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. A. L. D. Fraser, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

Right of Maoris to vote for Europeans.

A. Every adult Maori who is not disqualified under some provision of the principal Act shall, if he or she so desires, be entitled to be enrolled under Part II. of that Act, and all the provisions of that Act shall extend and apply to every such Maori:

Provided that if the name of any Maori who claims to be enrolled under this section is already on the roll of any Maori electoral district his claim shall, if approved by the Registrar, be dealt with in the manner prescribed by section thirty-three of the principal Act in the case of claims of transfer from another district.

Repeal.

B. Section twenty-eight of the principal Act is hereby re-

pealed.

Amendment of form for enrolment. C. The form of claim for enrolment numbered (1) in the First Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the words "or, if a half-caste, I am a half-caste aboriginal native of New Zealand."
