ELECTORAL ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. SEDDON, in Committee, to move the following new clause, to follow clause 13:—

13A. Section eighty-five of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting next after the words "the Fifteenth Schedule hereto" the words "(or in electorates at any time hereafter constituted within what, in the opinion of the Governor, are substantially the same geographical areas)"; and also by adding at the end of the section the following words: "For the purpose of this section the Governor, as soon as conveniently may be after the constitution of new electorates, shall, by notice in the *Gazette*, specify those in which the poll shall close at seven o'clock, and such notice shall be conclusive evidence of the matters stated therein."
