NOTICES RELATING TO ORDERS OF THE DAY.

Hon. Mr. Stout, in Committee on the Civil Service Acts Amendment Bill, to move the insertion of the following new clause:-

> Every officer and person now in the Civil Service who has entered such service prior to the passing of the Amendment Act shall be entitled to reckon in the computation of his retiring allowance the time during which he was in the employment of the New Zealand Company, or in the service of any Provincial Government; and the provisions of sections thirty and thirty-one of the said Act shall extend and apply to all such officers and persons accordingly.

Mr. Kelly, in Committee on the Civil Service Acts Amendment Bill, to move the following proviso to clause 3:-

> Provided that no person who ceased to be a Civil servant before the coming into operation of the Amendment Act, and who has been reappointed to the Civil Service after such Amendment Act came into operation, shall thereby become entitled to any retiring allowance under the said Act.

- Hon. Mr. Stout, in Committee on the Land Claims Final Settlement Bill, to move the insertion of the following new clause:-
- 10. Nothing contained in this Act shall be deemed to revive any No lapsed claims claim that may have been considered to have lapsed, although the same may be included in the Schedule hereto.
- Mr. Montgomery, in Committee on the Ellesmere and Forsyth Reclamation and Akaroa Railway Bill, to move,—
 - 8. The lands described in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby vested in the said Trust for the purposes of the said Trust, with power from time to time to appropriate any or all of the said lands for the proposed railway, and to sell in manner hereinbefore mentioned any of the surplus thereof not required for such railway.

9. The Colonial Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay to the special account in the sixteenth section of the said Act mentioned all the proceeds of the sales of the land, in the said section mentioned as appropriated for the Trust, remaining after the payment of the three thousand pounds in the said section mentioned.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

All that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Canterbury, being a line of tramway one (1) chain wide, commencing at the southern boundary of Section No. 1753, and terminating at the western boundary of Reserve No. 1229, as the same is delineated on the plan deposited in the Survey Office, Christchurch.
