ELECTORAL BILL.

Mr. SAUNDERS, in Committee, to move, That the following words be added to clause 78:—

And as soon as the time has expired for receiving nominations the Returning Officer of the district shall call by similar advertisement a meeting of electors, and of the candidates who have been nominated, to be held not less than three days before the polling-day at seven *post meridian* in some building in the district which he may deem most convenient for the greatest number of the electors. At such meeting the Returning Officer shall preside as chairman, and shall call in alphabetical order upon each candidate, if present, to address the electors for not more than one uninterrupted half-hour, and afterwards to answer such questions on any public question as may be put to him by any elector.

Hon. Sir J. HALL, in Committee, to move,—

In the interpretation clause, page 5, line 23, to omit the words “does not include,” and substitute the word “includes.”
