ELECTORAL BILL.

Hon. Mr. MITCHELSON, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 3: After the definition of "Person" insert: "Postmaster" means any person for the time being in charge of a post office who has been appointed by the Governor to exercise any of the functions of a Deputy-Registrar under this Act.

Clause 4: After "assistance of the Registrars and" insert: "Appoint such Postmasters in country districts as he shall think fit to exercise such functions and duties of Deputy-Registrars, in respect of receiving claims or

otherwise, as he may from time to time prescribe.'

Clause 11: Omit all words after "purpose" in line 26. Insert "in the presence of the Registrar of the said district, or such other officer as mentioned in section eighteen, at any time after the commencement of this Act, make and deliver, to such Registrar or other officer, a claim and declaration in the form or to the effect set forth in the First Schedule."

Section 18: Omit all words of the first paragraph after "district," in line 34, and substitute "or a Postmaster acting as Deputy-Registrar thereof, who shall transmit such claim to the Registrar by post, and free of postage."

First, Second, and Third Schedules at foot, in attestation clause, omit

"or Justice of the Peace," and "or an elector of the district."
