ELECTORAL BILL.

Hon. Mr. BALLANCE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Page 5, line 14: Omit “published,” substitute “printed in some newspaper published, or if there be none, then.”

Page 7, line 4: Before “vote” insert “or her.”

Page 8, lines 27 and 28: Omit all words between “registration” and “he or,” substitute “elect the district and the qualification in respect of which respectively.”

Page 21, line 45: Before “notice” insert “public;” and add to the clause “and the said fifteen days shall be inclusive both of the first day on which the notice is published and of the day of polling.”

Page 23, line 19: After “same” insert “or in any way similar.”

Page 32, line 46: After *Gazette* insert “When such vacancy shall have arisen from any cause other than death or resignation, then.”

Page 33: Before clause 138 insert,—

When such vacancy shall arise from death or resignation the Speaker shall issue his warrant to the Clerk of the Writs forthwith, directing him to issue a writ to supply the vacancy.
