ELECTORAL BILL.

Colonel FRASER, in Committee, to move, That the last clause of section 9 be expunged.

Mr. CARNCROSS, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

That the word "man" be deleted in clause three, line six, with the view of inserting in lieu thereof the word "elector."

Mr. BLAKE, in Committee, to move,—

That the female franchise shall not come into operation until after the next general election.

Mr. WRIGHT, in Committee, to move the insertion of the following new clause, in substitution for clause 107:—

Every voter for the district may vote for one candidate only, and may not give more than one vote to such candidate. Every ballot-paper recording more than one vote at any election shall be rejected at the close of the poll.
