EXHIBITIONS BILL.

Hon. Mr. MILLAR, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

To omit clause 8, and substitute the following:—

8. (1.) The Governor may, by Order in Council, remit or reduce, as he thinks fit, the duties of Customs or excise payable in respect of goods for the purpose of any exhibition named in the Order.

(2.) The Governor may also, by Order in Council, modify, suspend, or alter the provisions of the Customs Law Act, 1908, the Beer Duty Act, 1908, or any other Act relating to Customs or excise with respect to goods for any exhibition specified in the Order.

Clause 9: To add the following subsection:—

(2.) Nothing in this section shall authorise the working by any person of a greater number of hours in any day or in any week, nor the payment to any person of a lower rate of wages than is provided for ordinary work under any Act, or any award or industrial agreement under the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908.
