EXPEDITIONARY FORCES BILL.

AMENDMENT proposed by His Excellency the Governor:

To omit clause 23A, and substitute the following:—

Evidence.

23a. On every trial by court-martial in New Zealand of any offence committed out of New Zealand by a member of an Expeditionary Force the Court may, notwithstanding anything in the Army Act, receive and act on such evidence as it thinks fit, whether legally admissible in other proceedings or not:

Provided that the verdict of a court-martial on such a trial shall have no force or effect until it is confirmed by the Governor in

Council.
