EDUCATION LEGISLATION AMENDMENT

*Proposed Amendments*

Hon WYATT CREECH, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 29:* To omit from *new section 77A (1)* the words “younger than 16” (page 26, line 18).

To omit subsection (2) of *new section 77A* (page 26, lines 19 to 24), and substitute the following subsection:

“(2) When a student moves from one registered school to another registered school, the principal of the first school must take reasonable steps to send the student’s enrolment record to the principal of the second school.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper corrects an anomaly in the Bill as reported back from the select committee, under which principals would not have been obliged to maintain enrolment records for students aged 16 years or over. Since these records are necessary for funding purposes, the enrolment records of all students enrolled at a school should be maintained.
