ELECTORAL LAW REFORM BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 3 Separate Bills

Hon. W. P. JEFFRIES, in Committee, to move as follows:

That clauses 2 to 73A and the First Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

## An Act to amend the Electoral Act 1956

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Electoral Amendment Act (No. 2) 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electoral Act 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 10th day of March 1990.

That clauses 74 to 99 and the Second Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for clause 74 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to provide for the holding, in conjunction with the 1990 General election, of a poll to decide whether the term of Parliament should be increased from 3 years to 4 years

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title, commencement, and expiry**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Term Poll Act 1989.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1990.

(3) This Act shall expire with the close of the 31st day of March 1991, and on the close of that day shall be deemed to be repealed.

That clauses 101 to 134 and the Third Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for clauses 101 and 102 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to provide for the taking of polls in no-licence districts

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Local Restoration Polls Act 1989.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1990.
