EDUCATION RESERVES AMENDMENT BILL.

Right Hon. Sir J. G. WARD, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

A. (1.) All expenses of administration may be deducted from the revenues received by the Receiver of Land Revenue, and paid by him into the Public Account to the credit of the Lands and Survey Vote:

Provided that the total amount of such deductions shall not exceed in any one year five per centum of the total amount of rent received by the Receiver on account of lands leased under the authority of this Act.

(2.) Such expenses may be deducted either daily, weekly, or quarterly as may be most convenient, and shall include all expenses incurred, whether in respect of the collection of rents, the inspection of land, or otherwise howsoever.
