EDUCATION REFORM BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 6 Bills

Hon. Dr LOCKWOOD SMITH, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *Part I* and the Schedules be a separate Bill; and that for the heading "PART I AMENDMENTS TO EDUCATION ACT 1989" and *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Education Act 1989

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

2. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act (No. 3) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Act 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as provided in sections 6 (4), 16 (2), 17 (2), 18 (2), and 35 of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1992.

That *Part II* be a separate Bill; and that for the heading "PART II AMENDMENTS TO QUEEN ELIZABETH II TECHNICIANS STUDY AWARD ACT 1970" and *clause 36* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Queen Elizabeth II Technicians Study Award Act 1970

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

36. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Queen Elizabeth II Technicians Study Award Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Queen Elizabeth II Technicians Study Award Act 1970 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1992.

That *Part III* be a separate Bill; and that for the heading "PART III AMENDMENTS TO CHILDREN'S HEALTH CAMPS ACT 1972" and *clause 38* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Children's Health Camps Act 1972

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

38. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Children's Health Camps Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Children's Health Camps Act 1972 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1992.

That *Part IV* be a separate Bill; and that for the heading "PART IV AMENDMENTS TO NEW ZEALAND COUNCIL FOR EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH ACT 1972" and *clause 42* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the New Zealand Council for Educational Research Act 1972

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

42. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Council for Educational Research Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the New Zealand Council for Educational Research Act 1972 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1992.

That *Part V* be a separate Bill; and that for the heading "PART V AMENDMENTS TO PRIVATE SCHOOLS CONDITIONAL INTEGRATION ACT 1975" and *clause 44* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

44. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Private Schools Conditional Integration Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1992.

That *Part VI* be a separate Bill; and that for the heading "PART VI AMENDMENTS TO EDUCATION LANDS ACT 1949" and *clause 46* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Education Lands Act 1949

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

46. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Education Lands Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Lands Act 1949 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1992.
