# Supplementary Order Paper

ELECTORAL REFORM BILL

*Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 2 Bills*

Hon. D. A. M. GRAHAM, in Committee, to move the following motion:

That *Part I* and the Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* and the heading to *Part I* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Electoral Act 1993**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Electoral Amendment Act (No. 2) 1995, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electoral Act 1993 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as provided in sections 5 (2), 6 (2), 7 (2), 24 (3), and 38B of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

That *Part II* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 47* and the heading to Part II there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Citizens Initiated Referenda Act 1993**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Citizens Initiated Referenda Amendment Act (No. 2) 1995, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Citizens Initiated Referenda Act 1993 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The motion in this Supplementary Order Paper divides the Electoral Reform Bill into 2 Bills, namely,—

- (a) The Electoral Amendment Bill (No. 2);
- (b) The Citizens Initiated Referenda Amendment Bill (No. 2).
