Right Hon. Mr. NASEH, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

To add the following new clause:—

New Clause

57. Notwithstanding any enactment or rule of law to the contrary, in any case where financial or other assistance has, whether before or after the passing of this Act, been granted to any person under Part I of the Rehabilitation Act, 1941, any contract, deed, or other document relating to the assistance and executed by that person and by any infant being the wife of that person shall, if the infant executed the document with the prior approval of the Public Trustee, be as valid and effectual as if the infant at the time of executing the contract, deed, or other document had been a person of full age.
