FENCING AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. HOUSTON, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

Notwithstanding anything in "The Impounding Act, 1884," a fence shall, in addition to the descriptions given in Schedule A of the principal Act, if not a boundary-fence, mean a fence with three or more barbed wires tightly stretched between posts of durable wood or iron not more than nine feet apart, and substantially erected.
