FACTORIES AND SHOPS BILL.

Mr. RHODES, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

In Section 58A, line 39, that the word “town district” be inserted after the word “city,” and consequential amendments in 59A and 60A be made in the Bill.

INDUSTRIAL SCHOOLS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. HISLOP, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

9A. Any Resident Magistrate may from time to time vary or cancel any order made by him under the said Act which is erroneous either in form or in substance, and, if necessary, may make a new order in substitution of any order so cancelled.

AUCTIONEERS BILL.

Mr. VALENTINE, in Committee, to move,—

In clause 14, after the word “Act” in line 16, to insert the following words: “and subsection (3) of section 28 of the said Act shall be read as if the words ‘person carrying on business as an auctioneer, or being in partnership with any one carrying on such business, or to’ had been omitted therefrom.”

WELLINGTON SCHOOL OF DESIGN AND EXCHANGE BILL.

Hon. Mr. HISLOP to move the following amendment as a substitute for clause 3:—

The land described in the *Second* Schedule hereto is vested in the Education Board of the District of Wellington as a site for an office for the said Board, and as a site for a School of Arts, Design, and Technics: Provided that the same shall be inalienable by sale, mortgage, or otherwise howsoever, except with the previous authority of a special Act.
