### Foreshore and Seabed Bill

#### *Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills*

Hon Dr Michael Cullen, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2, Parts 1 to 4, and Part 6, and Schedules 1 and 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words and *clauses 1 and 2* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

#### **The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

##### **1 Title**

This Act is the Foreshore and Seabed Act 2004.

##### **2 Commencement**

- (1) This section and **Part 1 and Part 2** (other than **sections 9A, 21, and 22**), and **sections 114 to 117, and Schedule 3** (other than the provisions that relate to sections 43, 72, and 98 of Te Ture Whenua Maori Act 1993) come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on 17 January 2005.

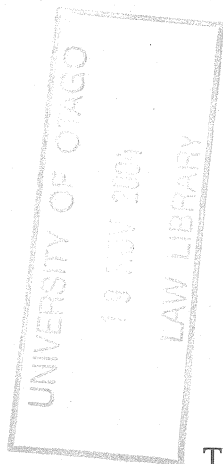
That *Part 5 and Schedule 4* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 5* heading and *clause 72* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

#### **The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

##### **1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Resource Management (Foreshore and Seabed) Amendment Act 2004.
- (2) In this Act, the Resource Management Act 1991<sup>1</sup> is called "the principal Act".

**2 Commencement**

- (1) This section and **sections 73, 83, 94, 95, 99, 100, 100A, 106A, and 106B** come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on 17 January 2005.
