## Supplementary Order Paper

FILMS AND VIDEO RECORDINGS AMENDMENT BILL  
*Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 2 Separate Bills*

Hon. MARGARET AUSTIN, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *Part I (clauses 2 to 8)* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

**An Act to amend the Films Act 1983**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Films Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Films Act 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the 14th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

(3) Sections 4, 5, 6, 7<sup>b</sup> (2), and 8 of this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1990.

That *Part II (clauses 9 to 14)* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 9* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

**An Act to amend the Video Recordings Act 1987**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Video Recordings Amendment Act 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Video Recordings Act 1987 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the 14th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

(3) Sections 10 (2), 11, 13, 13A, and 14 (3) of this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1990.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper (which supersedes Supplementary Order Papers Nos. 160 and 184) contains the appropriate motion to divide the Films and Video Recordings Amendment Bill into 2 separate Bills—the Films Amendment Bill and the Video Recordings Amendment Bill.
