NOTICES RELATING TO ORDERS OF THE DAY.

FENCING BILL.

Mr. Acton Adams, in Committee, to move the following amendments:-

Section 16, line 8. After the word "residence," to insert the words, "or by posting the same to such occupier or owner by registered letter addressed to such residence."

Section 18, line 39. To strike out the words, "or at any time within six months thereafter."

Section 28, line 20. After the word "lands," to insert, "and when the boundary line shall run over lands upon which it is extremely difficult or impossible to maintain a permanent fence."

Same section, line 22. After "watercourse," to insert, "or lands." Section 30, line 56. To strike out the word "ten," and insert "fifteen."

Section 37, line 60. After the word "fences," to insert the words, "and as to the position or line thereof."

After section 4, in Schedule, to insert,—

A substantial wire fence, with posts of hardwood or iron, well and substantially erected of six wires, the top wire being not less than 3 feet from the ground, and the standards not more than 12 feet apart, with two lacings of wire between them.
