ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS SALE CONTROL ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Dr. NEWMAN, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

In clause 8, subsection (2), line 39, to omit the words "Not less than five per centum nor more than."

FENCING BILL.

Hon. Mr. J. MCKENZIE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 3, subclause (1): After the words "Native Land Court," insert the words "or otherwise."

Clause 5: Strike out the new proviso.

Clause 8: Strike out the new proviso.

Clause 17, line 38: Add to new proviso, "Provided further that, upon the expiry or earlier determination of such lease, the person who becomes the occupier shall be liable, as set forth in subclause (1) of this clause.

Clause 42: Retain the clause; but, in line 32, after "proceedings," insert "before the Magistrate," and strike out all the words after "under this Act."

ENDOWED SCHOOLS BILL.

Hon. Mr. REEVES, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Section 2: To omit the words "nor any school maintained chiefly for the benefit of Maoris."

And to insert after section 8 a new section: "The Minister of Education may institute inquiry as to the sanitary condition of any endowed school maintained chiefly for the benefit of Maoris, and may require, at the hands of the governing body of the same, such improvements therein as to him may seem to be necessary."
