FINANCE BILL.

AMENDMENTS proposed by His Excellency the Governor-General:—

Clause 14: To omit this clause.

Clause 37, subclause (6): To add to the subclause the words “unless after the birth of the child its parents have intermarried.”

Clause 48, subclause (1): To omit the words “the purpose or purposes for which such loan was raised may be varied, or.”

Clause 48, subclause (2): To omit the words “to vary the purpose or purposes of any such loan, or”; and also the words “as the case may be.”

Clause 48, subclause (4): To omit from this subclause all words after the words “approved by it.”

Clause 49: To omit the words “to vary the purposes of any loan raised by it, whether before or after the passing of this Act, or”; and to omit the word “such” before the words “loan unexpended.”
