FINANCE (REVENUE) BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 4 Bills

Hon. WYATT CREECH, in Committee, to move the following motion:

That Part I and the First Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Customs Act 1966

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Customs Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Act 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 31st day of July

1991.

That Part II and the Second Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for clause 4 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Tariff Act 1988

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Tariff Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tariff Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 31st day of July

1991.

That Part III be a separate Bill, and that for clause 6 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Income Tax Act 1976

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Income Tax Amendment Act (No. 4) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Income Tax Act 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of August

1991.

That Part IV be a separate Bill, and that for clause 11 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Stamp and Cheque Duties Act 1971 BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—This Act may be cited as the Stamp and Cheque Duties Amendment Act (No. 2) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Stamp and Cheque Duties Act 1971 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of August

1991.
