FINANCE BILL, 1932-33 (No. 2).

AMENDMENTS proposed by His Excellency the Governor-General:

Clause 8: To insert, after the word "amended" in the second line of the clause, the words "as from the passing of that Act".

Clause 18, subclause (5): To omit all words after the words "equal to five per centum thereof" in the fifth line of the subclause, and substitute the following:

"The remainder shall be paid into the Public Account, and shall

be dealt with as follows:-

"(a) So much thereof as was paid in respect of motorvehicles using electricity as their main motive power shall be dealt with as provided by section nine of the Motor-spirits Taxation Act, 1927:

"(b) So much thereof as was paid in respect of all other motor-vehicles shall be divided into as many equal portions as, at the beginning of the month in which the tax became due and payable, there were full pennies of Customs duty (exclusive of primage duty or surtax) payable on motor-spirits imported into New Zealand. Six of such portions shall be dealt with as provided by section nine of the Motor-spirits Taxation Act, 1927, and the residue shall be credited to the Consolidated Fund."

New Clauses.

To add the following new clauses:—

3A. The Minister of Finance may, under the authority Minister of of section seven of the Banks Indemnity (Exchange) Act, 1932-33, issue Treasury bills in respect of the discount on bills for any other Treasury bills issued under the authority of discount on Treasury bills that section, or may pay any such discount in cash in issued under accordance with the said section.

30A. (1) Section sixteen of the Finance Act, 1927, is hereby amended as from the passing of that Act by inserting, after the words "for the public work", the words Section 16 of "or other purpose", and by omitting the words "for the Finance Act, purposes of the public work".

(2) After the passing of this Act the power conferred by the said section sixteen to apply the proceeds of any loan to which that section relates for the repayment of other moneys applied for the purpose for which the loan was raised shall not, unless and until the Local Government Loans Board consents thereto, be exercised at any time after the expiration of two years from the date of the application of such other moneys.

39. Subsection one of section two of the Rent Extension of Restriction Act, 1932, is hereby amended by omitting duration of law as to restriction the words "first day of August", and substituting the of rent until

words "thirty-first day of October".
