FINANCE (NO. 2) BILL

Proposed Amendments

Land and Income Tax

That clauses 2 and 3 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Land and Income Tax Act 1954 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Land and Income Tax Amendment Act 1974, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Land and Income Tax Act 1954 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Unit Trusts

That clauses 4 and 5 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 4 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Unit Trusts Act 1960

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Unit Trusts Amendment Act 1974, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Unit Trusts Act 1960 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Perpetuities

That clauses 6 and 7 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 6 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Perpetuities Act 1964

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Perpetuities Amendment Act 1974, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Perpetuities Act 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Estate and Gift Duties

That clauses 8 and 9 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 8 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Estate and Gift Duties Amendment Act 1974, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Stamp and Cheque Duties

That clauses 10 and 11 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 10 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Stamp and Cheque Duties Act 1971 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Stamp and Cheque Duties Amendment Act 1974, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Stamp and Cheque Duties Act 1971 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
