# Supplementary Order Paper

FINANCE BILL (NO. 5)

*Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 14 Bills*

Hon. DAVID CAYGILL, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *Part I* and the *First* Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Income Tax Act 1976**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Income Tax Amendment Act (No. 9) 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Income Tax Act 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *Part II* and the *Second* and *Third* Schedules be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 17* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Land Tax Act 1976**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and application**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Land Tax Amendment Act (No. 3) 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Land Tax Act 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as provided in **sections 24 and 25** of this Act, this Act shall apply with respect to the land tax for the year of assessment commencing on the 1st day of April 1990 and for every subsequent year.

That *Part III* and the *Fourth* Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 27* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Customs Act 1966**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Customs Amendment Act (No. 4) 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Act 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 28th day of July 1989.

That *Part IV* and the *Fifth Schedule* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 31* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Tariff Act 1988**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Tariff Amendment Act 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tariff Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 28th day of July 1989.

That *Part VI* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 40* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Accident Compensation Act 1982**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Accident Compensation Amendment Act (No. 2) 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation Act 1982 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1989.

That *clauses 48 and 49* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 48* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Bank of New Zealand Act 1988**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Bank of New Zealand Amendment Act 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Bank of New Zealand Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 50 and 51* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 50* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Housing Corporation Act 1974**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Housing Corporation Amendment Act 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Housing Corporation Act 1974 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 52 and 53* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 52* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the New Zealand Railways Corporation Act 1981**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Railways Corporation Amendment Act (No. 2) 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the New Zealand Railways Corporation Act 1981 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 54 and 55* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 54* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Rural Banking and Finance Corporation Act 1974**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Rural Banking and Finance Corporation Amendment Act (No. 3) 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rural Banking and Finance Corporation Act 1974 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 56 to 58* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 56* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the State-Owned Enterprises Amendment Act (No. 7) 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 59 to 62* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 59* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Social Security Act 1964**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Social Security Amendment Act (No. 3) 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security Act 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be fixed by the Governor-General by Order in Council.

That *clauses 65 and 66* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 65* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Medicines Act 1981**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Medicines Amendment Act 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Medicines Act 1981 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 67 and 68* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 67* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Government Life Insurance Corporation Act 1987**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement—**(1) This Act may be cited as the Tower Corporation Amendment Act 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Act heretofore known as the Government Life Insurance Corporation Act 1987 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1989.
