FINANCE BILL (NO. 6)

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 3 Separate Bills

Hon. DAVID CAYGILL, in Committee, to move as follows:

That clauses 2 to 4 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Tourist and Publicity Department Act 1963

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Tourist and Publicity Department Amendment Act 1989, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tourist and Publicity Department Act 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That clauses 5 to 25 and the First and Second Schedules be a separate Bill, and that for clause 5 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to enable the Tourist Hotel Corporation of New Zealand to dispose of any of its property or business and to enable the Corporation to be constituted as a company under the Companies Act 1955

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Tourist Hotel Corporation of New Zealand Act 1989.

(2) Except as provided in subsections (2) to (4) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

(2) Sections 14 to 19 and section 21 of this Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed for the commencement of those sections by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and one or more Orders in Council may be made bringing different sections into force on different dates.

(3) In the case of section 15 and section 19 of this Act, a date may be appointed only where the Governor-General in Council is satisfied that on the date appointed for the coming into force of

those sections, not all the ordinary shares in the capital of Tourist Hotel Corporation of New Zealand Limited will be held on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen.

(4) In the case of section 17 of this Act, a date may be appointed only where the Governor-General in Council is satisfied that on the date appointed for the coming into force of the section, at least 50 percent of the ordinary shares in the capital of Tourist Hotel Corporation of New Zealand Limited will no longer be held on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen.

That clauses 26 and 27 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 26 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to dissolve the Phosphate Commission of New Zealand

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Phosphate Commission of New Zealand Dissolution Act 1989.
